The traditions and heritage of the cities of the island are diverse. All the cities covered in this itinerary are recognized by UNESCO.

Havana declared one of the Seven Wonder Cities of the World in June 2016, Havana has something for everyone. It highlights the historic center of Old Havana, which achieved World Heritage status granted by UNESCO in 1982.

Villa Clara's culture is one of the most influential at the national level. It is the origin of several of the most renowned artists in the Cuban cultural panorama. Several are its festivities and popular traditions, among which the Parrandas Remedianas, the "Parrandas Remedianas", the "Parrandas Remedianas" and the "Parrandas Remedianas" stand out.

Trinidad de Cuba has one of the most beautiful and best preserved architectural complexes in the Americas, recognized as the Museum City of the Caribbean Sea, its historic center was declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1988, together with its Valle de los Ingenios (Sugar Mill Valley).

Located in south-central Cuba, the province of Cienfuegos is a land of proud and charismatic Cubans, with a historic center recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 2005. It is the only Cuban city born of parents from other countries, mostly French, so its environment is characterized by that Frenchified air that is still perfectly preserved today.
