The traditions and heritage of the island's cities are diverse. All of those covered in this itinerary are recognized by UNESCO.

In the province of Camagüey, the capital city bursts forth, with its superb bell towers and the elegant longevity of the buildings that were once the center of the village of Santa María del Puerto del Príncipe: a labyrinth of streets, alleys and squares without equal in the Caribbean, declared a World Cultural Heritage Site in 2008.

The destination of Holguín is distinguished by its authenticity, diversity and high level of sustainability. It stands out for its picturesque reliefs of great landscape value.

Baracoa is the tourist region identified as “Las Terrazas de Cuba al Mar Caribe” for being “El Alto Oriente Cubano”, internationally known for the song “La Guantanamera” and for Baracoa as the First Cuban Village since 1511. In addition, a rich history and culture highlighted by “Three World Heritage Sites”: the Alejandro de Humboldt National Park, core of the “Cuchillas del Toa Biosphere Reserve”; the French Tomb and the French Coffee Plantations.

The historical, musical and festive city of Santiago de Cuba is the cradle of son and bolero, birthplace of some of the greatest exponents of Cuban music: Compay Segundo, Níco Saquito and Sindo Garay were born in Santiago; cultural par excellence.
